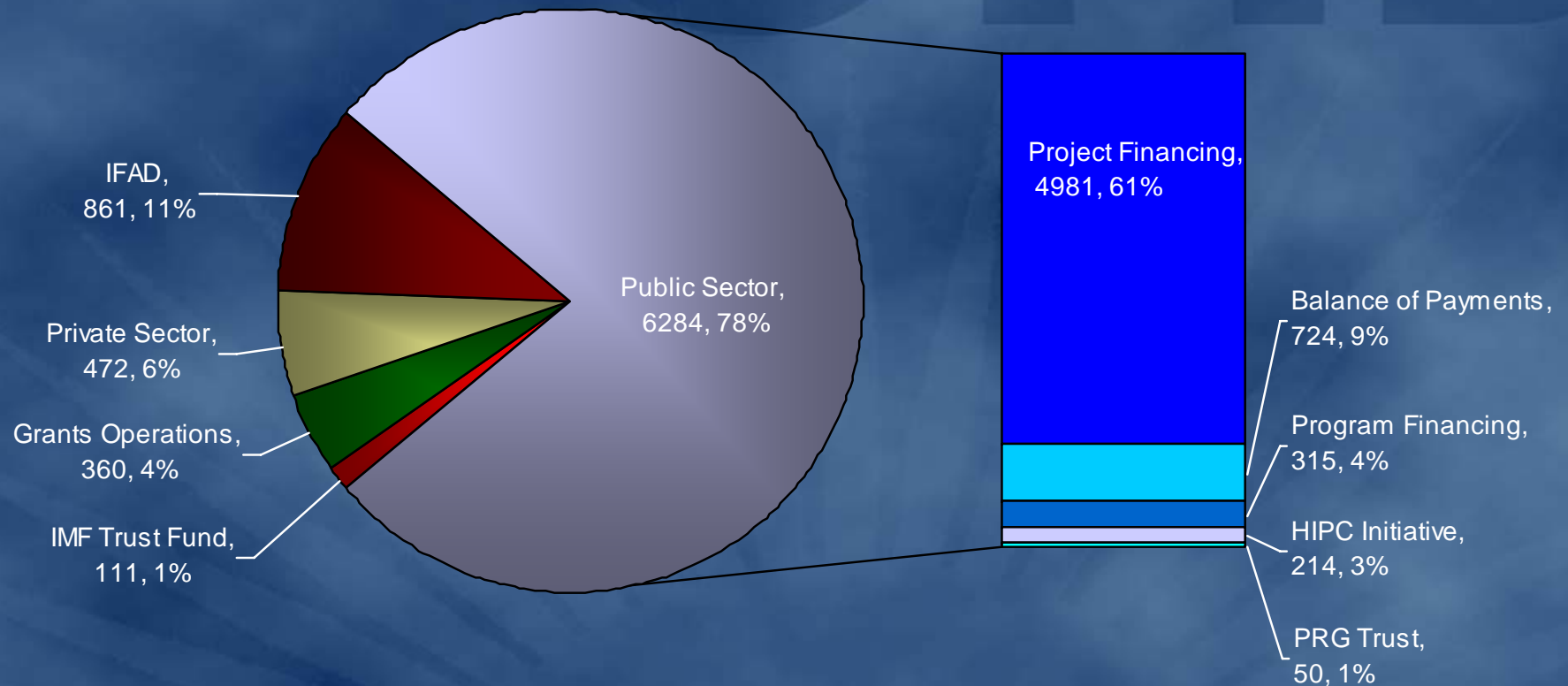

(in US\$ million *as of June 2006*)



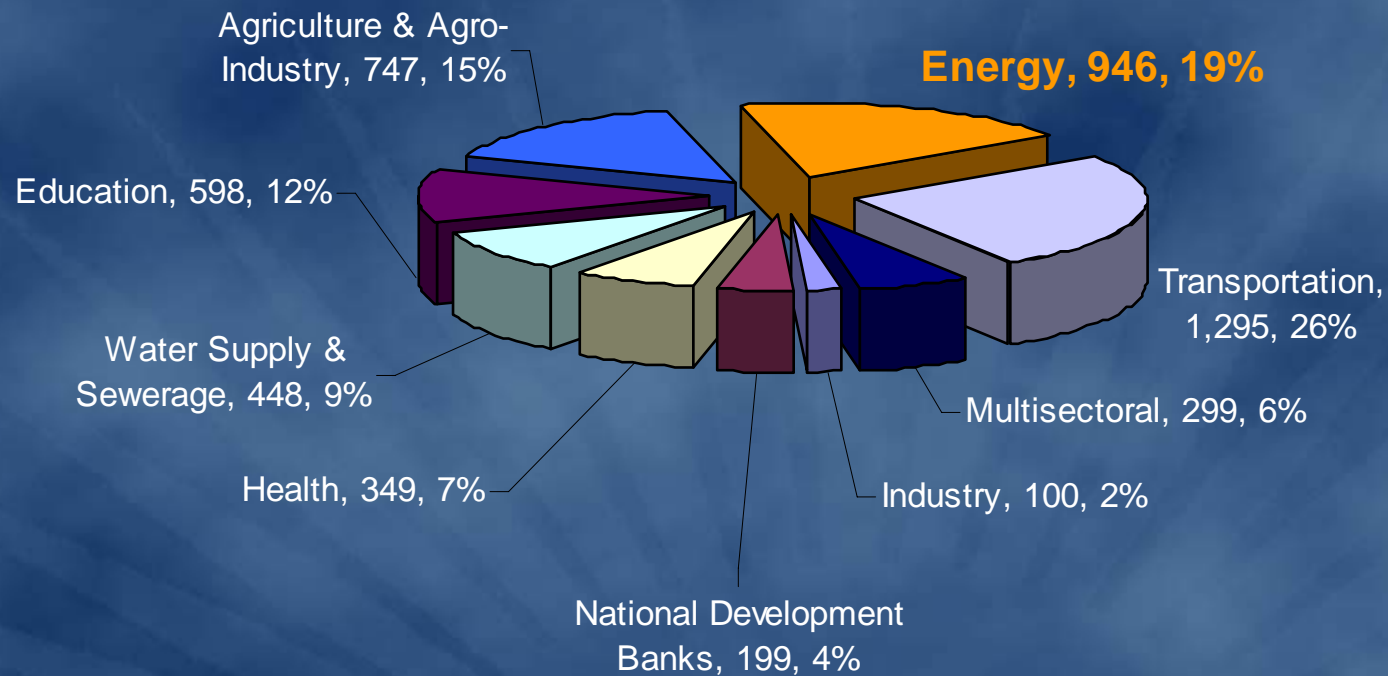
Total commitments : US\$ 8.09 billion

By Economic Sector (in US\$ million)

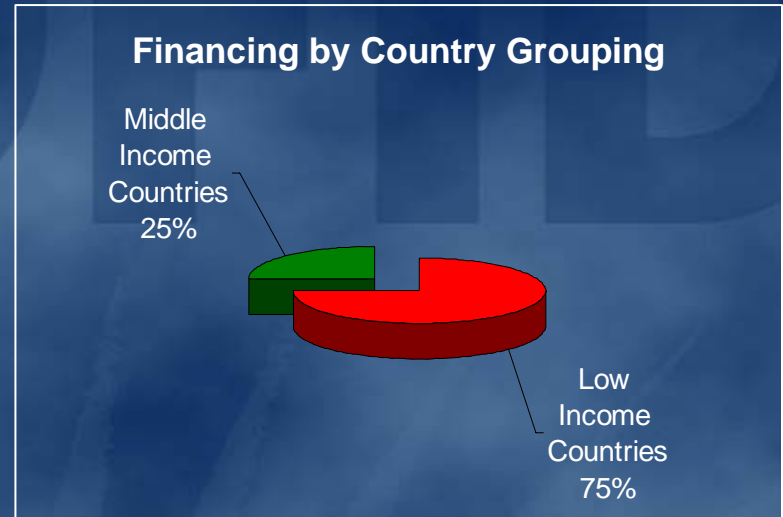
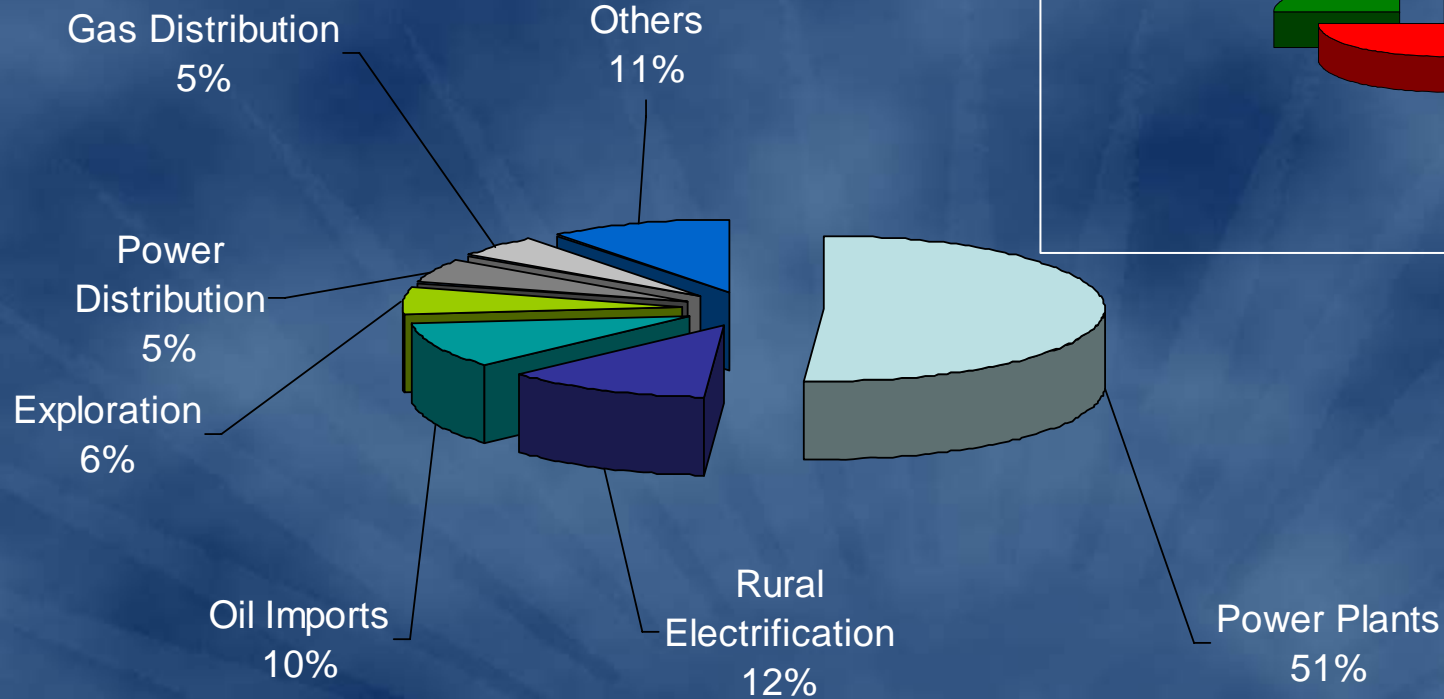

Energy Projects Financing by Sub-sector

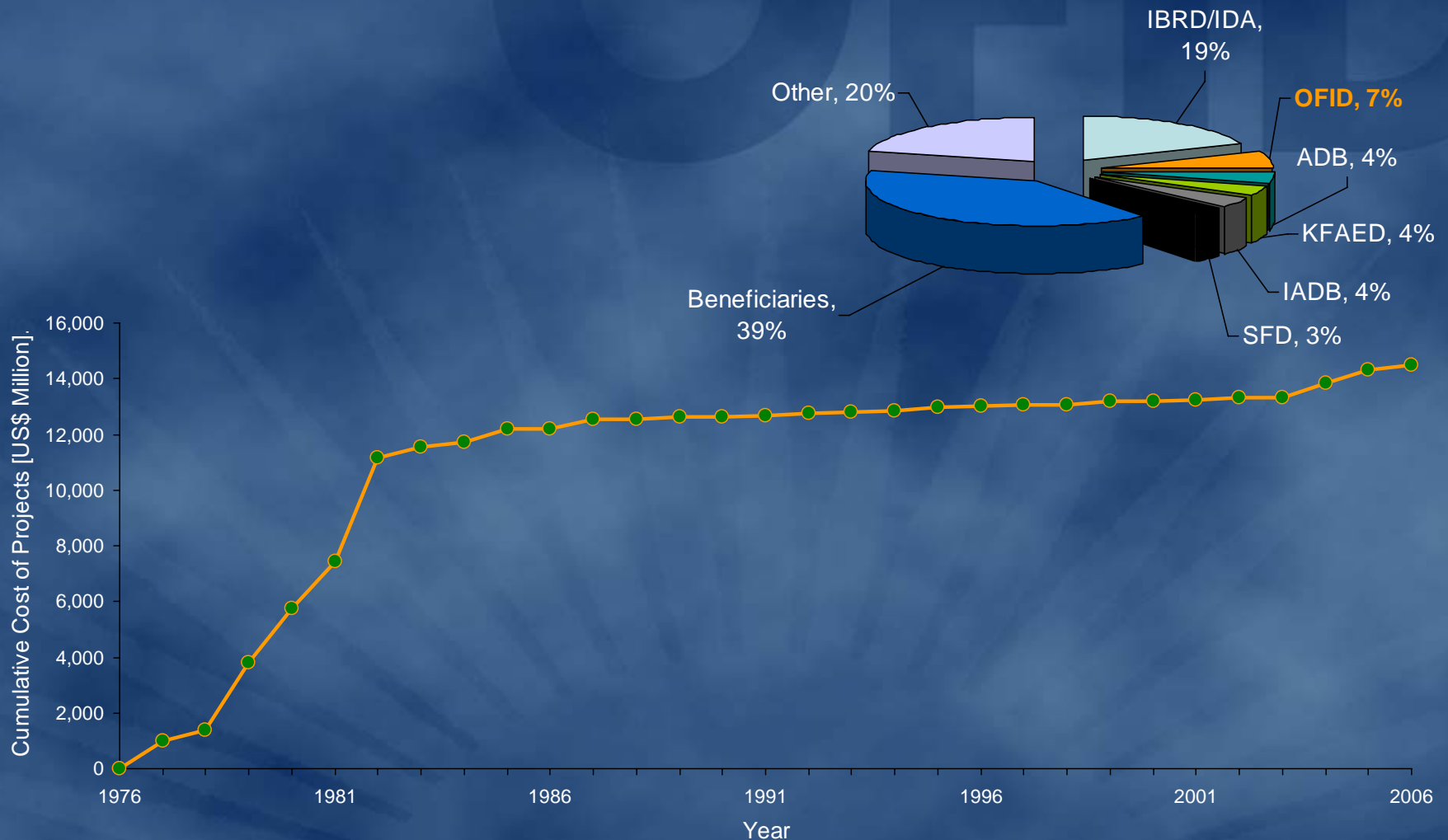

Volume and Geographical Distribution of Arab Aid

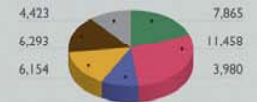

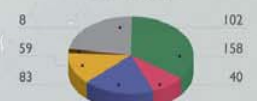

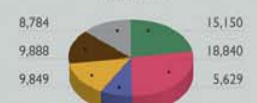
