

The OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional 2023

Call for nominations

The call for nominations for the 2023 OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional has begun. The OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional recognizes past efforts and encourages future endeavours. In this regard, it honours young scholars who have made outstanding contributions to increasing knowledge of the energy industry.

The presentation of the first OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional will take place in Vienna, Austria, on 5–6 July 2023. Organizations and institutions are invited to nominate qualified candidates to be considered for this Award.

Objective of the Award

The OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional recognizes past efforts and encourages future endeavours. In this regard, it honours young scholars who have made outstanding contributions to enhancing knowledge of the energy industry.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional, the recipient must:

- i. Have consistently maintained high achievement levels over recent years, including the production of a substantial record of publications;
- ii. Have shown dedication to research and analysis of important oil-related issues;
- iii. Show the impact he/she has made in the energy industry;
- iv. Have contributed to an improved understanding of key determinants that support oil market stability;
- v. Have demonstrated a high level of objectivity and integrity in his/her work;
- vi. Prove his/her commitment to the industry through pursuing excellence in his/her work;
- vii. Demonstrate innovative thinking and/or leadership skills;
- viii. Have achieved distinguished personal development within their role;
- ix. Demonstrate high integrity and ethical behaviour;
- x. The nominee should be aged under 40.

Nominations

Individuals, institutions and/or organizations can nominate candidates for the OPEC Award for the Best Young Energy Professional by filling out the nomination form.
